EAA's Aeromedical Advisory Council member Dr. Gregory Pinnell, M.D., received the Michigan 2012 FAA Safety Team Representative of the Year Award at last week's Great Lakes International Aviation Conference.

The award was presented by the FAA Flight Standards District Offices of Michigan for his significant contributions to aviation safety.

Dr. Pinnell is a senior AME and board certified family practitioner in a multi-specialty medical center in Saginaw, Michigan. He serves as a senior flight surgeon for the 45th Space Wing, Patrick AFB, United States Air Force Reserve Medical Corps, and frequently supported the space shuttle program. He also currently works medical logistics for the Soyuz Space Program.

As an EAA Aeromedical Advisory Council member, Dr. Pinnell frequently contributes to articles in *Sport Aviation* as well as provides webinars regarding a variety of aeromedical topics. He has been guest speaker at many local EAA

chapters and has presented multiple forums on aeromedical issues at AirVenture.

Dr. Pinnell is an adjunct professor for Western Michigan University's College of Aviation and teaches aviation physiology. An instrument-rated private pilot, he owns and flies a Piper Cherokee Six.



From the Flight Surgeon

Just getting back into the plane after a long winter? You will undoubtedly do a more thorough preflight on the old bird but don't forget the little carbon monoxide (CO) detector stuck on your panel. These detectors which turn color when exposed to CO only last on average from 28 days to 18 months depending on the brand. They are inexpensive and provide protection from the colorless, odorless gas which can (and has) incapacitated and killed aircraft crew and passengers. The usual cause of CO poisoning in single engine aircraft are exhaust leaks and leaks into the cabin heater shroud which surrounds the exhaust.

Early signs of carbon monoxide poisoning can include headache, dizziness, weakness, nausea, vomiting, and confusion. Continued exposure can result in unconsciousness or death.

Update:

A significant change in FAA medical policy occurred recently as the Federal Air Surgeon published new policy on Certificates an AME can issue or "CACI". This change in policy allows AME's to issue medicals for specific diagnosis without the usual Special Issuance required by the FAA. The diagnosis are Arthritis, Asthma, Glaucoma, Hepatitis C - Chronic, Hypertension, Hypothyroidism, Migraine and Chronic Headache, Pre-Diabetes, and Renal Cancer. Certain medical documentation is required to issue the medical but it does not have to be sent in to the FAA. The medical is good for the normal duration of the certificate depending on the class.

More medical conditions are expected to be placed in the CACI program as information is released by the FAA. Fly safe!
